Session 1 – LIFE

Is life expendable?

Examining the ethical approaches of Kant, Bentham, Aristotle and Aquinas in addressing the question of whether it is ever right to take or tamper with life. With particular application to Euthanasia and current technological advances, we will explore the Sanctity of Life principle and whether it has any relevance in a secular culture.

Session 2 – LANGUAGE

Is talking about God and Ethics a meaningless waste of breath?

Examining whether we can meaningfully talk about what is 'good' and 'right' as well as whether any kind of God-talk is nonsense. We will explore how these two topics interrelate as well as whether all news is essentially 'fake news'.

Session 3 - GOD

Is the idea of 'God' incoherent (and irrelevant)?

Examining the traditional 'proofs' for the existence of God including Ontological, Cosmological and Teleological arguments. We will also explore the classical understanding of 'God' looking at both Boethius and Swinburne and discuss whether the notion of God needs re-imagining for the 21st century.

Session 4 – **GENDER**

Does gender matter?

Examining the development of feminism, changing attitudes towards gender and the impact of Christian theology on gender bias. We will explore how theories of Ethics, Language and God are impacting this debate and ask whether a gender neutral society is possible or even desirable?

Conference content is relevant to all A Level Exam boards for both Religious Studies & Philosophy as well as International Baccalaureate and PreU courses.
